

World Series of Archery Quickstart Guide

Qualifying Round

The Qualifying round will consist of 32 arrows shot into the large 4 spot targets with an additional final arrow shot into the “Closest to Center” spot at the conclusion of the 8th end.

Four Scoring Spots:

8 Ends
4 arrows per end
3 minute time limit
Targets switched at half (4th end) from top to bottom and bottom to top

Closest to Center (C2C) Final Arrow:

Shot as 5th arrow after the 8th end. (before archer leaves the line)
1 minute time limit

Scoring:

Scoring rings on the Four Scoring Spots and the C2C spot score the same. Starting with the innermost ring and moving outward, the rings score as follows: 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5

Four Scoring Spots must be scored in order 1-4. (spots may be shot in any order)

Greatest scoring emphasis on final score will be the Closest to Center Final Arrow score. (Ex. An 11-350 beats a 10-352)

Highest score possible is 11-352 (C2C final arrow of 11 and 8 perfect ends of 44)

Scorecard:

8 Scoring End boxes-

Value of each arrow scored in numerical order
Total score of each end
Total score of each half

Final Arrow box-

The score of the Closet to Center Final Arrow

Tie Breakers:

Ties will be broken as follows

1. Closest to Center Final Arrow Score
2. Total Score from 32 arrows
3. Value of First Arrow, second arrow, third arrow, until tie is broken

If ties cannot be broken based on arrows shot, the archers tied will shoot 1 end for score, this will consist of 4 arrows into the 4 spot targets followed by 1 Closest to Center Final Arrow

Qualifying Archers

In a tournament format, the number of archers who will qualify for the Elimination round will be based on the number of archers who enter the tournament. This format should require the need of archers to qualify multiple times in order to shoot a score good enough to qualify. An example;

8-15 shooters	=	4 shooter bracket
16-31 shooters	=	8 shooter bracket
32-63 shooters	=	16 shooter bracket
64-127 shooters	=	32 shooter bracket
128-255 shooters	=	64 shooter bracket

There will be a random draw to determine where the qualified shooters will be placed in the bracket and who their opponents will be.

Elimination Round

The Elimination round will consist of 1 end of 4 arrows shot into 4 large spots with a 3 minute time limit. At the conclusion of the 3 minutes or when the line is clear, the clock will be reset to 1 minute and the final arrow will be shot into the "Closest to Center" spot. Like above, the C2C final arrow will count first, if there is a tie on the C2C arrow, then the value of the 4 arrows will be counted.

Leagues:

Shot over 6 weeks (recommended)
5 weeks of qualifying scores
with each archer's highest score to be used as a ranking
The final week will be the elimination round and should include all archers
